### My dear parishioners,

Happy Christmas! On Christmas Day we celebrate the greatest gift the world has ever received, the gift of Christ the Saviour, the Light of the World. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, God's Son became flesh in the womb of the Virgin Mary and was born, in great simplicity, at Bethlehem. Joseph, faithful and sincere, became their trusted guardian.
