Updates/Requests

- Details of road closures around St Mary' and St Paul's from 26th November to 5th of December available from South Lanarkshire Council website.
- Father O'Brien to discuss with electrician improving the lighting at the bottom of the car park stairs.
- Introduction of card machine in the parish to be discussed fully at the January meeting.
- Usage of the QR code for donations to the parish to be reviewed.
- Continuing our support for Mary's Meals representatives will be invited to the parish in February.
- Defibrillator training on the 4th of October completed.
- A suggestion has been put forward for evening adoration at key points throughout the year.
- Census at masses in the last week in October recorded an attendance of approximately 650 over the 3 masses. Compares well with the previous year.
