First Sunday of Advent

December 3rd 2023

Dear parishioners at St. Mary's and St. Paul's,

Let me wish you a very happy and fruitful Advent! Today in the life of the Church a new liturgical year begins, which is a new journey of faith for the pilgrim People of God. How wonderful is that! Somehow it always feels like a great privilege to be part of this, to have the opportunity, for one more year, to make this journey of faith as we reflect together on the great mystery of Christ our Saviour. And as always, we begin with Advent.

The word *Advent* means *arrival* or *presence* and in ancient times it was used to describe the arrival or presence of a king or queen or some other dignitary. We now use this word *Advent* to describe the visit of the Lord to humanity. Of course the first visit is the one we look forward to celebrating at Christmas, the birth of Jesus in the stable at Bethlehem; the second *arrival* or *presence* takes place in the present, in the power of the Spirit, as the Lord visits us constantly, each day, walking alongside us and being a consoling and life-giving presence; in the end there will be the final visit, which we proclaim each time that we recite the Creed: "He will come to judge the living and the dead."

In describing the season of Advent, Pope Francis says, "we are called to expand the horizons of our hearts, to be amazed by the life which presents itself each day with newness. In order to do this, we must learn not to depend on our own certainties, on our own established strategies, because the Lord comes at a time we do not imagine. He comes to bring us into a more beautiful and grand dimension." Let us pray for one another during this holy season of Advent, praying for a new Springtime in the life of the Christian Church here in Scotland and especially in our own parish. Father O'Brien
