My dear parishioners at St. Mary's and St. Paul's,

Let me wish you and your families a very Happy Easter. Bishop Toal has sent the following Easter Message to the priests and people of the Diocese:

"I wish everyone a very Happy Easter and pray for the blessing of the Risen Lord upon us all and our world. We pray that the peace offered by Christ as he appeared to his disciples at Easter may reign everywhere, especially among the peoples of his own land. May new hope spring up, even among the debris of war and the awful reality of human suffering and death.
